COUNT I Unlawful Use Of Weapon - Subsection 4 - Exhibiting

In violation of in violation of Section 571.030.1(4), RSMo, committed the class D felony of unlawful use of a weapon, punishable upon conviction under Sections 558.011 and 560.011, RSMo, in that on or about August 22, 2016, at , in the County of Johnson, State of Missouri, the defendant knowingly exhibited, in the presence of one or more persons a handgun, a weapon readily capable of lethal use, in an angry or threatening manner.

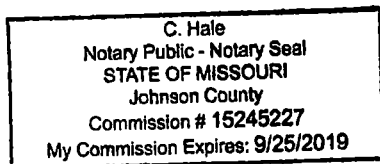
Wherefore, the Prosecuting Attorney prays that an arrest warrant be issued as provided by law.


PROBABLE CAUSE STATEMENT

I, Gary Schmidt, upon my oath, and under penalty of perjury, state as follows:


1. I have probable cause to believe that Keemo Rei'Diem Rudolph committed one or more criminal offenses.
2. The facts supporting this belief are as follows:
 - a. On 08/2/2016 University of Central Missouri Police Officers responded to a fight that involved firearms at University of Central Missouri parking lot #12, 102 East Clark Street, in the City of Warrensburg, Johnson County, Missouri.
 - b. Upon arrival, officers talked with several witnesses who stated they observed an argument involving several males in two different groups. The witnesses stated they saw two of the males display firearms and point them at another group of males. The witnesses stated the males left the area in an orange Chevrolet Camaro.
 - c. Warrensburg Police Department Officer Hiatt observed orange Chevrolet Camaro, and a white Honda travelling on Missouri Highway 13 near East Division. Warrensburg Police Department Hiatt activated his emergency light, and the Chevrolet Camaro, and the white Honda, which was in front of the Camaro, also stopped. The white Honda was being driven by the Defendant.

- d. Several witnesses were taken to the scene of the car stop and positively identified the Defendant as one of the males who point a firearm at the group of male. Several witnesses said they feared for their safety when the Defendant displayed his firearm.
- e. A firearm was located in the Defendant's short's pocket. The firearm had a full magazine of ammunition in it.
- f. The Defendant was taken into custody, and transported to the University of Central Missouri, Department of Public Safety.
- g. The Defendant was given his Miranda warning, and agreed to talk about the incident. He admitted to being involved in the argument with the other group of males, and admitted pointing a firearm at them.
